To play, players must have raised at least £15 sponsor money for the BHF. We wish to enter a junior team to compete in the British Heart Foundation Junior Golf Championship 2015 and agree to be bound by the Conditions of Entry and the Rules. We enclose a cheque for the full entry fee per team. Cheques are payable to British Heart Foundation.

Conditions of Entry

- To play, players MUST have raised AT LEAST £15 sponsor money each for the BHF. All sponsor money raised to date MUST be brought on the day to the qualifying tournament selected. However, players are encouraged to collect additional sponsor money afterwards, in order to qualify for the top fundraising prizes.
- To register, an entry fee of £25 per team is required. This goes towards the cost of staging the Championship. Discount for multiple team entry is also available (£40 for two teams, £50 for three).
- Participants take part at their own risk.
- To take part in any sponsored event for the BHF players must be in good health. If in any doubt, they must first consult their doctor.
- Players taking part in the competition remain the legal responsibility of the golf club or school that they are representing. One adult MUST accompany each golf club/school team taking part and must remain at the golf club during play.
- The contact/team manager must obtain the permission of the players' parents/guardians for their children to take part in the Championship.
- All players must adhere to the Conditions of Entry and the Rules. Failure to comply could result in disqualification.
- To be considered for top fundraising prizes or qualification for the Grand Final through exceptional fundraising, all sponsorship money must be received by Friday 12 June 2015.

Rules

Teams: A team consists of three players. All players must be a member of a bona fide golf club and can be of either sex. All players of the team must be a member of the golf club or attend the school they are representing. A player is only allowed to represent one school or golf club in the Championship. In the event of a tie, the third score counts followed by best back 9/6/3/1 holes.

Age: Entrants must be aged 18 or under at 00.00 hours on 31 August 2015.

Handicap: The maximum handicap is 28 for boys and 36 for girls. All players must produce a valid handicap certificate from a bona fide golf club on the day of the competition. This certificate must be signed and dated by a club official. The date of the certificate should be within 14 days of each day of play. Failure to produce a valid handicap certificate properly dated will mean a handicap of scratch will be allocated. In the latter stages of the competition, the BHF will invoke clause 19.6 of the CONGU Handicap Guidelines if it is felt necessary. This clause allows organisers of an event to make reductions in handicap for that competition. For handicap purposes this is a non-qualifying event and no competition SSS will therefore be calculated.

Substitutes: After a qualifying tournament only one substitute will be allowed, unless specifically approved by the Championship Committee. Substitution of any player who has already taken part for another team from their golf club/ school or any other golf club/school is prohibited.

Disqualification: If disqualified, a player cannot take part in any further rounds of the Championship.

Caddies and Buggies: Caddies and buggies are prohibited in this Championship.

Golf Rules: Failure to comply with the rules of The R&A or the additional Championship rules will mean the player could be disqualified from that round of the Championship and no score will be recorded.

Referee: The decision of the BHF organiser and appointed referee will be final.
