## Checkpoint location listing for support drivers

### **The Start - Chilcomb Sports Ground**

Petersfield Road (A31), Winchester SO21 IHU  
Free parking (all cars must be removed from site by 9:00am)  
Tea, coffee and breakfast snacks to buy  
Toilets

### **Checkpoint 1 - Queen Elizabeth Country Park**

Gravel Hill, Horndean PO8 0QE  
Pay and display parking  
Lime cafe open from 7am  
Toilets

### **Checkpoint 2 - Manor Farm**

Hill Barn Lane, Cocking, off the A286, GU29 0HS  
Free parking in farmer's field (no longer parking in Cocking public car park)  
Portable toilet  
Teas and coffees, refreshments to buy

### **Checkpoint 3 - Bury Hill**

A29, Bury  
No parking available – this checkpoint is really only used as a safety measure for the riders, support drivers should not attend.

## **Checkpoint 4 - Washington Bostal car park**

RH20 4AX. Off the A24 (southbound side, or through Washington village  
Height restricted parking, and limited space.

## **Checkpoint 5 - Bramber**

layby off A283 Shoreham road-, BN44 3TU

If you're traveling south on the A283, the checkpoint is situated shortly after the roundabout in a layby on the right. There are 6' 6" height restrictions

Free limited parking in layby

## **Checkpoint 6**

### **Start of 35 mile route - Devils Dyke**

Dyke Road, Poynings, Brighton BN1 8YJ

Pay and display parking next to the pub

Toilets available in the pub

Snacks, refreshments and full meals from the pub, a few moments from the checkpoint.

## **Checkpoint 7 - Itford Farm Lane**

Off the A26, Beddingham, Lewes, BN8 6EP

Very limited parking available – this checkpoint is really only used as a safety measure for the riders and it is recommended that support drivers do not attend.

## **Checkpoint 8 - River Lane**

Alfriston, Polegate, BN26 5SX

STRICLY NO ACCESS for support vehicles directly at the checkpoint, however there is an assortment of free and pay and display parking available in the town.

Public toilets are available at the northern end of the town in the short stay car park.

Food and drink can be purchased from a variety of pubs and cafes etc.

## **Finish of 100 mile & 35 mile route - Western Lawns**

King Edwards Parade, Eastbourne, BN21 4EQ

Inexpensive pay and display parking along road next to finish site. Free parking available in residential streets close by.

Toilets, food and drink to purchase.
