



Start up Grant

Terms and Conditions of the Heart Support Group Start up Grant

1. Your group must use the grant to support the activities specified in your start up grant application form.
2. You must retain proof of expenditure (e.g. receipts) and make it available to the BHF on request.
3. Your Heart Support Group must be affiliated to the BHF in order to receive a start up grant.
4. All start up grants will be paid by cheque. The cheque will be sent to you with your award letter and will be made payable to the group account specified in your start up grant application form.
5. We can only pay grants into a bank / building society account which is in the name of your group and which requires at least two authorized people to sign each cheque or withdrawal.
6. Your group is only entitled to receive one start up grant, for a fixed sum of £500.
7. We'd be delighted if you'd like to acknowledge our support in your advertising, publication and / or project materials. Your group can use the phrase 'affiliated to the BHF' on publications, posters and your website, provided it's not for fundraising purposes. Your group cannot use the BHF name except in this phrase.
8. The BHF logo and charity number cannot be used at any time.
9. By accepting the grant offer you agree to the BHF publishing case studies or other details of your work, as it's vital we can demonstrate how our money is spent and the benefit it gives to the wider community.
