

## Terms & Conditions

### **British Heart Foundation's London to Brighton Bike Ride 2026 – £50 Amazon gift card Prize Draw**

3. There will be ten (10) winners. Each winner will win one (1) x £50.00 Amazon gift card.
4. The winner(s) will be picked at random and will receive a £50.00 Amazon gift card to their email address before the event takes place.
5. The winner will be selected at random from all eligible entries within seven (7) days of the closing date. To notify the winner, a representative from British Heart Foundation will be in contact via email and/or phone.
