Explain to students that CPR is a life saving skill

In Norway 1 in 4 people survive. Why? Because CPR training is more widely taught in schools. Right now only 1 in 10 people in the UK survive a cardiac arrest.

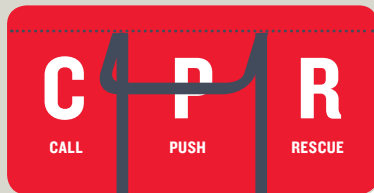
! Tell pupils how many people are in your assembly hall, and how many of them would survive according to these stats.

! Tell pupils about Samantha. A normal girl who did an extraordinary thing. Her mum stopped breathing and she saved her life.

Reveal the CPR kit

! Tell pupils about Mission: CPR. This June and July your school and schools across the country will up skill in life saving skills. If you do the training, it means that if the worst thing happens, you'll know what to do.
