Get young people to hijack the PA system with the Bee Gees' Staying Alive and perform a quick round of CPR before calmly returning to their seats.

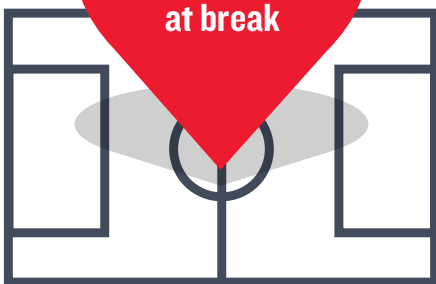

- 2 Grab your CPR kit and some volunteers – maybe have some way to play music
- 3 Walk into a social space and start doing CPR
