

# We've given our defibs the best chance of saving a life

There are more than 30,000 out-of-hospital cardiac arrests every year in the UK, but less than 1 in 10 people survive.

Every minute without CPR and defibrillation reduces the chance of survival by up to 10%.

That's why we've registered our defibs and regularly update their status on The Circuit, the national defibrillator network. This means the ambulance service can find them and trust they are ready to use in an emergency.

If a defib is not registered the ambulance service won't know it exists, and the opportunity to help save a life could be missed.
